

The Rt. Rev. Dr. P. J. Lawrence is the founder-Director of CTLT. He also teaches a number of courses in the areas of Church History and Biblical Studies. He was was born in Nandyal, AP, India. and obtained his Doctor of Ministry at the Columbia Theological Seminary, Atlanta, Georgia, USA, under the renowned Old Testament scholar, Professor Walter Brueggemann.

Dr. Lawrence was ordained for the ministry in the Church of South India (CSI) in 1971. He served as a full-time pastor in India until 1989. He was then sent as a missionary to the Caribbean. After serving as a missionary in Jamaica and the Cayman Islands for sixteen years, he became the Bishop of Nandyal Diocese in 2006. After his retirement as Bishop in 2012, he was invited to Mauritius as the Director of the Anglican Training Centre and served the Anglican Church of the Indian Ocean.

After a period of 10 years , Bishop Lawrence returned to the Cayman Islands.

Semester 1: 11 September to 17 November 2023 Subjects

- Biblical Theology (Theology of the Old Testament)
- Seminars on research and writing papers and thesis.

Semester 2: 8 January to 15 March 2024

- An understanding of society and social structural analysis
- Biblical Theology II (Theology of the New Testament)
- Christian Missionary Movements/ Global Missions (Evangelical, Pentecostal, Charismatic and others)

Semester 3:8 April to 14 June 2024

- Systematic Theology and Emerging Christian Theologies. (Women's theology, Caribbean Theology, Liberation theology and others)
- Ethical and moral response to contemporary issues and concerns. (race relations, poverty and inequalities, environmental and climate change, Artificial Intelligence, etc.)
- Compassionate care giving and counseling

Cost: One-time registrations: \$100. Fees for each subject of ten classes \$300

Students will be required to write a thesis paper of about 50 pages, double-spaced, or 12,500 words. Cost for supervision and evaluation of the thesis: \$300.

Interested students can audit any of the above subjects with the required fee and receive a certificate of participation.
